We are pleased to announce that due to funding provided by the Winter Park Health Foundation the School-Based Health Center located at Winter Park High School will be open for two weeks in July to provide nurse practitioner services. The dates of service are July 17-20 and July 24-27 from 8:30am-2:30pm. **Services are available by appointment only.** Since the health center is normally closed over summer, this is a great opportunity to get your student's school entry or sports physical examination BEFORE the start of school. You are encouraged to call on Thursday July 13 to schedule an appointment. We will have someone available from 8:30-2:30 on site to schedule appointments for the following two weeks.

### Services Include:

- Physical Examinations for school entry, sports participation, Special Olympics, daycare, camp and college
- Evaluation, diagnosis and treatment of sick children including the writing of prescriptions when indicated
- Transfer of up to date shot records to the required Florida form
- Referrals to community partners
- Health education and screenings

### We do not provide:

Laboratory studies, xray, immunizations, birth control and ADHD prescriptions
